Dear Parent or Guardian,

Thank you for your interest in Oneida Baptist Institute. Our goal is to provide each student with a quality Christian education, balancing classroom work and co-curricular activities with responsibilities and discipline.

The average American boarding school charges \$20,000.00 per year, and some as much as \$60,000.00 per year. Our room and board fees are income-based, with a maximum Kentucky resident fee of \$505.00 per month and a maximum out-of-state fee of \$565.00 per month. There is an additional annual entrance fee for each student, which is equal to one month's room and board fee. Parents are additionally expected to send their child \$45.00 to \$60.00 per month for personal spending.

Our admissions procedures are as follows:

- Call the admissions office at extension 233 as soon as possible for a telephone interview. This interview is conducted with the custodial parent or legal guardian, and is done to help us determine if OBI is the right educational choice for your child. It is suggested that the telephone interview be done before you return the completed application.
- **Complete ALL application forms--some forms must be notarized--and return them as soon as possible to the admissions department with the \$35.00 processing fee.** Also include:
 - ✓ a current immunization certificate from a doctor's office or state health department
 - ✓ a copy of your child's medical insurance card (front and back)
 - ✓ copies of your child's social security card
 - ✓ birth certificate.
- The transcript/records release and counseling/psychiatric release are enclosed. Please fill them out and give them to the appropriate people. Additional copies may be made. Requested information should be mailed or faxed to us.
- After **ALL** requested information has been received, each application goes through a review process. It is your responsibility to check on the status of your child's application. You may do this by calling extension 233 Monday-Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- When the review process is completed, normally in two to three working days, we will schedule an orientation. During orientation, you and the prospective student will have the opportunity to view the campus and learn more about our school. We will also conduct a private interview with the prospective student, followed by an interview with the parents. Orientations are done on Sundays by appointment only.

Students may enroll at various times throughout the school year, including summer. We enroll for grades 6 through 12.

The admissions department will be glad to answer any questions you might have concerning your child's enrollment in Oneida Baptist Institute. We look forward to hearing from you.
