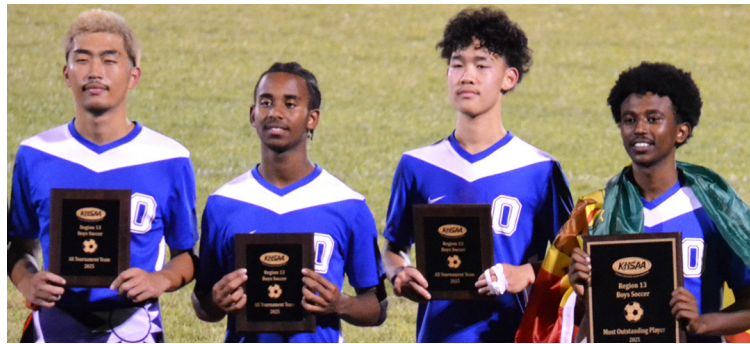


OBI Athletics News

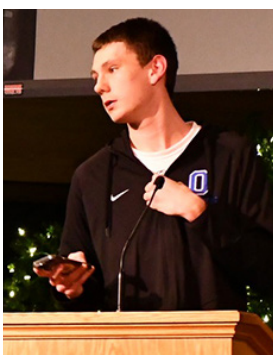
