

AG Coleman, former OBI student, shared testimony in chapel



Russell Coleman, Attorney General of Kentucky, was our guest speaker in chapel on February 28th. We learned that Mr. Coleman had attended OBI for one semester in high school and invited him to come and share with our students.

Mr. Coleman shared his testimony of how God opened the doors to become an FBI special agent. As a young adult, he was a church goer but said faith was something he did on Sundays because that was what was expect-

ed. "Faith was kind of like a box [to be] checked," he added. When he suffered a rare spinal tumor that caused paralysis, Coleman noted, "Laying in that hospital bed, faith became much more than a box to check. ... Faith became the very foundation I built the rest of my life on."

Relinquishing his personal identity as an FBI agent and embracing his identity in Christ, Coleman found renewed hope and new career opportunities that led to

him becoming Attorney General of Kentucky in 2024. "God's plan was a lot better than my plan. ... The job I do now is to work to protect you and your family," Coleman said.

He closed with Jeremiah 29:11, one of our favorite verses here at OBI, and encouraged the students by saying, "There is no one in this room I'm not talking to. ... There is no limit to the hope you can have in Christ."
