Fall Sports



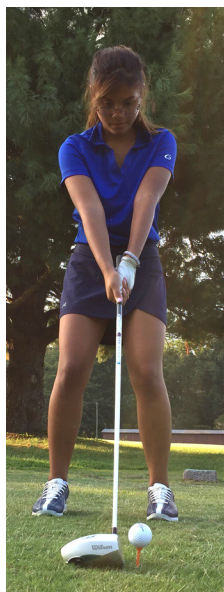

BCM's annual silent auction on 10/26 raised over \$300 for the purchase of Bibles to be distributed by the Voice of the Martyrs organization.



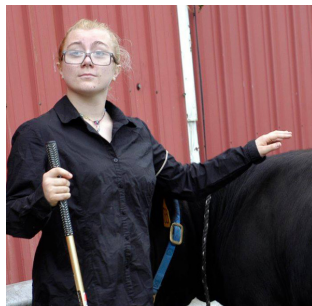


Homecoming & Fall Fest

Spring 2016 ACT DATES February 9 ~ April 3

The ACT is administered on the OBI campus. You must register online by logging on to your existing ACT student account or by creating a new account at: www.act.org. You must register six weeks ahead of the test date. For example: January 11, 2019 is the deadline for the February 9, 2019 test.

Practice tests are available at the Guidance Office. Students may also benefit from this online source:

www.actstudent.org/testprep

The cost of the standard ACT test is \$50.50 (standard, non-writing). If a student registers here on campus with the guidance office, the fee will be billed to the student's OBI account.

The guidance office prefers students create their own ACT account and register and pay for the test online. Just make sure to print the ticket (with uploaded photo) and have the student turn in a copy to the guidance office.
